## Class Information

**EVERY CLASS OFFERED , WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES & SPECIFICATIONS OF CURRENT USAE RULE BOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.**

**OPTION CLASSES** - there are 8 classes listed in the schedule as "Option Classes", which are classes not yet designated, and may be purchased by an exhibitor at a cost of \$50 each. The purchaser will be announced as the class sponsor. These classes **must be purchased by the entry deadline** so that adequate notification of the class additions may be made to the other exhibitors. Classes available are listed in Class Breakdown. Please contact Jane Pollard (972) 524-6137 for purchase.

**Leadline** - Stallions are prohibited. Rider's age 2 to 6 years, the "leader" must be at least 18 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: Saddle must fit rider; rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/ irons; lead rein may be attached to a cavesson or halter placed under or over bridle; safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider regardless of style of tack and/or attire; boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts are required (Res. 34-99). Leadline riders cannot cross-enter any other class in show. Leadline classes are exempt from AHA/USAE membership.

**Walk/Trot Pleasure and Equitation - 10 & Under** - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at an approved USAE or AHA competition that required a canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required, per appropriate USAE rules in equitation no tests will be called.

**AHA MEDAL CLASSES** - Open to juniors who did not reach their 18th birthday before December 1st of last year. For an AHA Medal to be awarded three entries with proper appointments must compete.

**AHA Saddle Seat Medal** - Following the rail work all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USAE Article 2219, Tests 1-15. Markers shall not be used.

**AHA Reining/Stock Seat Medal** - All contestants are required to perform the rail work and a Reining pattern as outlined in USAE Article 3310, other tests may be included from USAE Article 2225. If a rider is off pattern, rider is eliminated and not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.

**AHA Hunt Seat Medal Not to Jump (NTJ)** - Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

**Halter Showmanship** - Open to mares and geldings. NO STALLIONS.

**Driving** - Headers are permitted but not mandatory.

**Amateur Limited Rider Classes** - A rider may compete in the Amateur Limited Rider Classes unless or until he/she has won any of the following awards:

- a) A Regional Top Five (or better) in corresponding Open, AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- b) A National Top Ten (or better) in corresponding Open, AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- c) Two Regional Top Fives (or better) in corresponding Limited AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- d) A National Top Ten (or better) in corresponding Limited AAOTR or JOTR Class.
- e) A rider who begins the AHSA show year eligible to compete in these classes may continue to compete in them through that competition year regardless of winnings during the year. The rider, not the horse, determines eligibility.

## **General Information, Rules & Regulations**

**Entries** - Entries close Friday, August 22, 2003, those received after this date must possess a valid postmark earlier than August 22, 2002 or owner will be charged the post entry fee. All entries must be completed on an official entry form for this show, or an official AHA entry form and have attached a valid check or money order for the total amount of stall fees, AHSA drug fees, office fees, and class fees. Futurity Entries must be on separate Futurity Entry Form and paid by separate check from regular show entries. A horse may only be entered under the legal name of the owner; no horse may be entered on more than one entry form. **A copy of the front and back of all appropriate registration papers for each horse must accompany entry. If registration papers do not reflect current legal owner, additional paperwork is required. If entry is showing in Amateur Adult, Amateur or Junior Owner classes, leased horses may not be shown by the lessee unless the lessee and lessor are members of the same immediate family.**

**Returned Checks (NSF):** Exhibitor will be charged \$25, in addition to bank charges assessed for NSF Checks. If payment is not received within promptly to clear amounts owed, plus NSF Fee and bank charges - exhibitor's name will be turned in to Region IX and USAE, and will unable to show until amounts owed are paid in full.

**Health Certificate Coggins** - Any horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a current health certificate issued within 45 days by a licensed vet and presented at the show office before numbers will be issued for this or any other horses owned by the same owner. Horses with any communicable disease must immediately leave the show grounds. **A negative Coggins issued within 12 prior months is required for all horses.**

**Responsibility** - All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Arabian Horse Club of Texas nor the Nacogdoches Expo Center will be liable for any loss, injury or damage to horses, persons or any possessions while at the show. The authority of Show Management shall oversee all horses, although they remain the risk of the owner, exhibitor or trainer responsible for loss. Thus, the owner indemnifies the Arabian Horse Club of Texas and the Nacogdoches Expo Center against any and all loss, damage and/or liability including, but not limited to legal costs incurred as a result. A signed entry form constitutes acceptance of this policy.

**Cruelty or Abuse** - Cruelty or abuse is forbidden anywhere on the grounds. The Show Committee shall penalize such actions (USAE Rule III, Art.302). **Excessive harm to any horse (including harm caused by a whip or any other object) anywhere on the grounds before, during or after the show renders the offender subject to penalty.** Judges shall enforce this policy in the show ring. A signed entry constitutes acceptance of this policy.

**Discipline** - Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy or disobedience to any Show Official by an owner, trainer, groom or exhibitor will result in disqualification. Management may remove an owner/trainer/groom exhibitor without liability.

**Care of Animals** - Exhibitors are required to keep their animals as well as stalls clean and neat with refuse matter disposed of as the Horse Show Management may direct. Humane treatment must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees.

**Class Entries** - Show Management reserves the right to consolidate or cancel any class in which there are not at least five (5) entries. Classes containing over 40 entries will be split into two separate classes with the awarding of premium money and ribbons in each class. If class is split, Riders and/or horses may not show in both classes.

**Amateur Classes** - all riders in Amateur Classes **MUST HAVE** in their possession an Amateur Certification Card issued by USAE or make application for such card prior to riding in these classes. Applications may be secured from the Show Office.

**Wash Rack** - Washing of horses in any other location than wash racks provided, is prohibited.

**Stalls and stall assignments** - Stalls are full box stalls of wooden construction and have doors. Stalls will be available at 12 NOON ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3rd, 2003 and must be vacated by 8:00pm SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2003. Early move-in or late move-out fees will apply to any stall occupied other than these times at \$10.00 per night per stall (by request from Barn Manager). Stalls have a clay base (some sand). No bedding is provided, but will be available from the State Fair at a fair rate. A night watchman will be on duty in the barns and arena each night. Stalls will be assigned by Show Management upon receipt of stall fees. REQUESTS FOR ADJOINING STALLS MUST BE RECEIVED TOGETHER, AND ARE NOT GUARANTEED, BUT WILL BE HONORED WHENEVER POSSIBLE. Exhibitors will be charged for any stalls they use for any reason.

**Post Entries** - Post entries for show will be accepted for horses after closing date of August 22, 2003 at the regular fees plus the per horse post entry fee of \$20.00 (paid once per horse, not per class). NEW HORSES MUST BE ENTERED NO LATER THAN 2 HOURS BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE SESSION THEY ARE TO BE SHOWN IN.

**Stallions** - Arabian Stallions may be shown by ladies and children, except in Junior Halter Showmanship, Leadline and Walk/Trot classes.

**Refunds and Premium Payments** - Official notice must be received prior to the Entry Closing Deadline if any Horse is to be withdrawn. Otherwise, no refund will be paid except those with a licensed vet statement. Refunds approved by a vet are honored, if received in the Show Office by Noon the day before the 1st day of the show, class entry fees (only) will be refunded. There are no refunds of stall, office or other fees. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the show office during the show of any or all refunds due. Refund checks are mailed by 30 days after the show.

**Governing Organizations** - This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USA Equestrian (USAE), the Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Divisions. The official rules of these organizations shall prevail; any change or correction of these rules automatically becomes part of this premium. Each participant is subject to all rules as they apply. Any questions not covered by the rule books of these organizations shall be decided by the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

**USAE Membership** - Life, contributing, Senior, Junior and Affiliated members are eligible to participate in all classes at Regular member Competitions and Dressage. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, leasee, agent or trainer at Regular Member Competitions and Dressage upon payment of a \$20.00 non-member fee. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games/Races; 4) 4-H Classes; 5) Walk/Trot Academy and 6) USDF intro Level Tests. Also exempt are non-U.S. citizens who are members in good standing of their national federation. Non-members who wish to show in amateur classes must have applied for USAE "non-member amateur certification" prior to showing.

**AHA Membership** - all horses entered in any AHA approved show MUST be owned by a member of AHA, or pay the current AHA single event fee, including junior exhibitor owners. Any trainer, rider, driver or halter handler who exhibits a horse or signs the entry form is considered the 'responsible' party for horses entered on that form, and MUST be an AHA member or pay current AHA single event fee. PROOF OF MEMEBERSHIP IN AHA MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRY, OR AHA SINGLE EVENT FEES WILL APPLY - NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Show Office** - The Show Office will open at noon, Wednesday, September 3, 2003. Office hours will be posted in the Show Office. Phone Number of Show Office is: (214) 421-8836

I AM AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVES SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

## ***USDF Statement on Animal Welfare***

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 130 independent organizations throughout the United States with over 31,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a long-established classical method of training horses, based upon the nature and structure of the horse, carried out in a gradual, planned program. The horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of detrimental appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc. also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs that teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.
