CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Leadline – Stallions are prohibited. Rider's age 2 to 6 years, the "leader" must be at least 18 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: Saddle must fit rider; rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/ irons; lead rein may be attached to a cavesson or halter placed under or over bridle; safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider regardless of style of tack and/or attire; boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts are required (Res. 34-99). Leadline riders cannot cross-enter any other class in show. Leadline classes are exempt from IAHA/USAE membership.

Walk/Trot Pleasure and Equitation – 10 & Under – Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at an approved USAE or IAHA competition that required a canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required, per appropriate USAE rules in equitation no tests will be called.

IAHA MEDAL CLASSES - Open to juniors who did not reach their 18th birthday before December 1st of last year. For an IAHA Medal to be awarded three entries with proper appointments must compete.

IAHA Saddle Seat Medal – Following the rail work all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USAE Article 2219, Tests 1-15. Markers shall not be used.

IAHA Reining Seat Medal – All contestants are required to perform the rail work and a Reining pattern as outlined in USAE Article 3310, other tests may be included from USAE Article 2225. If a rider is off pattern, rider is eliminated and not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.

IAHA Hunt Seat Medal Not to Jump (NTJ) – Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from IAHA Article 1336.9.

Halter Showmanship – Open to mares and geldings. NO STALLIONS.

Halter Futurity – Held in accordance with USAE class specifications for each type of class, except that Half Arabian/AngloArabian Colts and Geldings will be shown in same class.

Driving – Headers are permitted but not mandatory.

Limited Rider – designation was voted to be changed starting in the 2004 Show Season at AHA Convention in December 2003 and at USAE Convention January to read **Select Rider** (AOTR, JOTR, ATR).

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USAE RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

General Information, Rules & Regulations

Entries – Entries close Monday, April 12, 2004, those received after this date must possess a valid postmark earlier than April 12, 2004 or owner will be charged a post entry fee. All entries must be completed on an official entry form for this show, or an official IAHA entry form and have attached a valid check or money order for the total amount of stall fees, AHSA drug fees, office fees, and class fees. A horse may only be entered under the legal name of the owner; no horse may be entered on more than one entry form. **A copy of the front and back of all appropriate registration papers for each horse must accompany entry. If registration papers do not reflect current legal owner, additional paperwork is required. If entry is shown in Amateur Adult, Amateur or Junior Owner classes, leased horses may not be shown by lessee unless lessee and lessor are members of the same immediate family.**

Health Certificate Coggins – Any horse entering the grounds must be accompanied by a current health certificate issued within 45 days by a licensed vet and presented at the show office before numbers will be issued for this or any other horses owned by the same owner. Horses with any communicable disease must immediately leave the show grounds. **A negative Coggins issued within 12 prior months is required for all horses.**

Responsibility – All entries are accepted with the understanding that neither the Arabian Horse Club of Texas nor the Nacogdoches Expo Center will be liable for any loss, injury or damage to horses, persons or any possessions while at the show. The authority of Show Management shall oversee all horses, although horses remain the risk of the owner, exhibitor or trainer responsible for loss. Thus, the owner indemnifies the Arabian Horse Club of Texas and the Nacogdoches Expo Center against any and all loss, damage and/or liability including, but not limited to legal costs incurred as a result. A signed entry form constitutes acceptance of this policy.

Cruelty or Abuse – Cruelty or abuse is forbidden anywhere on the grounds. The Show Committee shall penalize such actions (USAE Rule III, Art.302). **Excessive harm to any horse (including harm caused by a whip or any other object) anywhere on the grounds before, during or after the show renders the offender subject to penalty.** Judges shall enforce this policy in the show ring. A signed entry constitutes acceptance of this policy.

Discipline – Any act of dishonesty, discourtesy or disobedience to any Show Official by an owner, trainer, groom or exhibitor will result in disqualification. Management may remove an owner/trainer/groom/exhibitor without liability.

Care of Animals – Exhibitors are required to keep their animals as well as stalls clean and neat with refuse matter disposed of as the Horse Show Management may direct. Humane treatment must be exercised at all times by all exhibitors and their employees.

Class Entries – Show Management reserves the right to consolidate or cancel any class in which there are not at least five (5) entries. Large classes containing over 40 entries will be

split and become two separate classes with the awarding of premium money and ribbons in each class. Riders and/or horses may not show in both classes in case of a split.

Amateur Classes – all riders in Amateur Classes **MUST HAVE** in their possession an Amateur Certification Card issued by USAE or make application for such card prior to riding in these classes. Applications may be secured from the Show Office.

Wash Rack – Horses may only be washed in the wash racks provided. Washing of horses in any other location is prohibited.

Feed – There will not be feed available on the show grounds itself, however, a feed store is located next door to the show grounds.

Stalls and stall assignments – Stalls are full box stalls of metal construction, solid halfway up, metal bars on top half of stall, and have doors. Stalls will be available at 12 NOON ON THURSDAY, APRIL 22nd with early move-in (noon 4/21) or late move-out (4/26) available at \$12.00 per day (at request from Barn Manager). Stalls have a clay base (some sand). No bedding is provided, but will be available from the Expo Center at a fair rate. A night watchman will be on duty in the barns and arena each night. Stalls will be assigned by Show Management upon receipt of stall fees. REQUESTS FOR ADJOINING STALLS MUST BE RECEIVED TOGETHER, AND ARE NOT GUARANTEED, BUT WILL BE HONORED WHENEVER POSSIBLE. Exhibitors will be charged for any stalls they use for any reason.

Footing – Footing in arenas and warm up areas is of sandy loam. Arena size is 150' x 300'.

Post Entries – Post entries for show will be accepted for horses after the closing date of April 12th at the regular fees plus the per horse post entry fee of \$20.00 (paid once per horse, not per class). NEW HORSES MUST BE ENTERED NO LATER THAN TWO HOURS BEFORE THE PERFORMANCE SESSION THEY ARE TO BE SHOW IN.

Stallions – Arabian Stallions may be shown by ladies and children, except in Junior Halter Showmanship, Leadline and Walk/Trot classes.

Refunds and Premium Payments – Official notice must be received prior to the Entry Closing Deadline if any entry is to be withdrawn. Otherwise, no refund will be paid except those with a licensed vet statement. Refunds approved by a vet are honored if received in the Show Office by Noon the day before the 1st day of the show. If so, class entry fees (only) will be refunded. There are no refunds of stall, office or other fees. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to notify the show office during the show of any or all refunds due. Refund checks are mailed after the show.

Governing Organizations – This show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the USA Equestrian (USAE), the Arabian and Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian Divisions. The official rules of these organizations shall prevail; any change or correction of these rules automatically becomes part of this premium. Each participant is subject to all rules as they apply. Any questions not covered by the rule books of these organizations shall be decided by the Show Committee, whose decision will be final.

USAE Membership – Life, contributing, Senior, Junior and Affiliated members are eligible to participate in all classes at Regular member Competitions and Dressage. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, leasee, agent or trainer at Regular Member Competitions and Dressage upon payment of a \$25.00 Senior Non-Member fee or Junior Non-Member Fee of \$20.00. Participants in the following classes are exempt from the requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games/Races; 4) 4-H Classes; 5) Walk/Trot Academy and 6) USDF intro Level Tests. Also exempt are non-U.S. citizens who are members in good standing of their national federation. Non-members who wish to show in amateur classes must have applied for USAE “non-member amateur certification” prior to showing.

IAHA Membership – all horses entered in any IAHA approved show MUST be owned by a member of IAHA, or pay the current IAHA single event fee, including junior exhibitor owners. Any trainer, rider, driver or halter handler who exhibits a horse or signs the entry form is considered the ‘responsible’ party for the horses entered on that form, and MUST be an IAHA member or pay the current IAHA single event fee. **PROOF OF IAHA MEMBERSHIP MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRY OR IAHA SINGLE EVENT FEES WILL APPLY – NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Show Office – The Show Office will open at noon, Thursday, April 22, 2004. Office hours will be posted in the Show Office.
