Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.



Class Information – AHCT State Fair Horse Show

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN, WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES & SPECIFICATIONS OF CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK, WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

AHA Competition Level Membership card is required, or a single-event membership must be purchased for \$10.00.

Leadline - Stallions are prohibited. Rider's age 2 to 6 years, the "leader" must be at least 18 years of age. Safety is of the utmost importance in tack and attire: Saddle must fit rider; rider's feet must be engaged in the stirrups/ irons; lead rein may be attached to a cavesson or halter placed under or over bridle; safety helmets, with chin straps, may be used by any rider regardless of style of tack and/or attire; boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts are required (Res. 34-99). Leadline riders cannot cross-enter any other class in show. Leadline classes are exempt from AHA/USEF membership.

Walk/Trot Pleasure and Equitation - 10 & Under - Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Stallions are prohibited. Riders must have never been judged in any class at an approved USEF or AHA competition that required a canter or lope. The safety of all exhibitors is the primary concern in these classes. Any action by any exhibitor that endangers any other exhibitor must be severely penalized or excused, at the judge's discretion. Proper attire is required, per appropriate USEF rules in equitation no tests will be called.

AHA MEDAL CLASSES - Open to juniors who did not reach their 18th birthday before December 1st of last year. For an AHA Medal to be awarded three entries with proper appointments must compete.

AHA Saddle Seat Medal class.

- 1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF Tests 1-15 or EC equivalent. Markers shall not be used.

AHA Reining Seat Medal class.

- 1) All contestants are required to perform a Reining pattern as outlined in USEF Reining, or EC equivalent. (Res 25-06)
- 2) Dropping of bits is optional with the judge but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary, may be had from one of the ring officials.
- 3) Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
- 4) In an AHA Reining Seat Medal class an off pattern rider is eliminated and is not eligible to win a medal or ribbon.
- 5) The prescribed AHA Reining Seat Equitation Score Sheet must be used and posted in accordance with USEF rule AR199.5. (Res.25-06)
- 6) Numbers must be worn on the rider's back or in the case of reining seat equitation on the left side of the saddle pad and must be clearly visible at all times when in competition. See USEF rule EQ103.6. (Res. 8/07)

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal class.

- 1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from AHA Article 1336.9.

AHA Western Horsemanship Medal class.

- 1) Following the rail work, all contestants are required to perform a minimum of four tests from USEF AR224. (BOD 5/06)

Halter Showmanship - Open to mares and geldings. **NO STALLIONS.**

Driving - Headers are permitted but not mandatory.

Amateur Limited Rider Classes - A rider may compete in the Amateur Limited Rider Classes unless or until he/she has won any of the following awards:

- a) A Regional Top Five (or better) in corresponding Open, AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- b) A National Top Ten (or better) in corresponding Open, AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- c) Two Regional Top Fives (or better) in corresponding Limited AAOTR, or JOTR Class.
- d) A National Top Ten (or better) in corresponding Limited AAOTR or JOTR Class.
- e) A rider who begins the AHSA show year eligible to compete in these classes may continue to compete in them through that competition year regardless of winnings during the year. The rider, not the horse, determines eligibility.
